

CHILDRENS INFORMATION

We welcome children to our park but have high expectations regarding their behaviour. Please take note of the following information and remember that none of our play areas are supervised.

Noise Bearing in mind we have close neighbours with young children, please keep noise within reasonable levels during the evening. The recreation area opens at 9.00am and closes at 7.30pm and the play area opens from 9.00am to 9.00pm.

Cycling In the interests of safety and for everyone's comfort, we do not allow cycling around the park. However, children are welcome to ride their bikes in our general recreation area.

Water Pistols & Water Fights To avoid disruption to other campers and limit the mess in and around our toilet blocks, we do not allow the use of water pistols or water bombs on the park.

The Copse The copse has deep water and a number of half fallen trees and we request that you do not let your children play there. You are welcome to walk your dog in the copse, but please keep an eye on your children if they accompany you.

Dogs If you let your children take dogs for a walk, they must be on a lead and under control at all times around the park. You may let your dog off the lead on the dog walk and in the copse. **MAKE SURE YOUR CHILDREN HAVE POOPER-SCOOPER BAGS.**

Toilets Very young children should always be supervised in and around the toilet areas. We have provided high quality facilities on the site and hope you will help us keep them this way by not letting your children play in the toilets.

Gravel and Stones Please don't let your children throw stones or play with gravel on the grass. It can cause major damage and excessive wear to our mowers
